

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE CLAT ASPIRANTS

Increase in the intake of B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) Five-Year Integrated Degree Course of Maharashtra National Law University, Nagpur from the Academic Year 2017-18

The Executive Council of the University in its Meeting held on May 23, 2017, resolved to increase the intake of B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) Five-Year Integrated Degree Course from 60 (Sixty) to 120 (One Hundred Twenty) from the Academic Year 2017-18. The Core Committee of CLAT-2017 also approved the same in its meeting held on May 25, 2017. A communication in this regard has already been sent to Bar Council of India for necessary Approvals.

B.A.LL.B.(HONS.) FIVE-YEAR INTEGRATED DEGREE COURSE

Intake and Reservation: Total=120 Seats

The reservation policy of Maharashtra as envisaged in the Maharashtra National Law University Act 2014 would be made applicable and admissions will be made only on the basis of merit cum preference of CLAT-2017. The allocation of seats is as follows:

Note : (i) *The table above is prepared based on the Section 6(1) of the Maharashtra National Law University Act 2014 and Section 4(2) of the Maharashtra State Public Services (Reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, De-notified Tribes (Vimukta Jatis), Nomadic Tribes, Special Backward Category and Other Backward Classes) Act 2001 provided that the principle of " Creamy Layer" shall be applicable to all categories mentioned above except Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe.*

(ii) *3% seats shall be reserved horizontally for Specially Abled Persons (SAP) and any other reservation approved by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time.*
