## **B.A.LL.B. (Honours in Adjudication and Justicing) Admission** **Notification for Reserved Categories of Maharashtra** **(In Continuation to notification released on May 26, 2026)**

**Last Date for receipt of Filled-in Online Application Form: June 18, 2026**

Maharashtra National Law University, Nagpur was established by the Government of Maharashtra vide Act No. VI of 2014 to advance and disseminate learning and knowledge of law and legal process, and their role in national development. In furthering the vision of improving the quality of Justicing in the country by attracting the best talent and training them for courts, the University launched **B.A.LL.B. (Honours in Adjudication and Justicing)**, an Undergraduate Degree Course approved by the Statutory Bodies of the University and recognised by the Bar Council of India (BCI). This Five-Year duration degree course comprises of intensive and exhaustive practical training. B.A.LL.B. (Honours in *Adjudication and Justicing*) is a residential Degree Course that aims to equip the students with critical legal thinking for entry-level of the Judiciary and a successful Lawyer. Its curriculum focuses on pluralism, social integration, and the socio-cultural structure. Mock Trials, Clinical Legal Education, and field visits are an integral part of the curriculum through which students understand the application of classroom teaching and appreciate the socio-economic and legal issues.

**Note: Due to less number of applications received against the Notification dated May 26, 2026. Hence, this notification calls for applications from interested and eligible candidates.**

### **Eligibility:**

The candidates fulfilling the following criteria are eligible to apply:

- Candidates must have appeared in the CLAT 2026;
- Candidates must have completed Higher Secondary Education i.e., 10+2 or an equivalent examination with forty-five percent (45%) or its equivalent grade in case of candidates belonging to Unreserved / OBC / SBC/ EWS categories and forty percent (40%) marks or its equivalent grade in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/NT (A, B, C, D)/ PWD Categories;
- Candidate should be an Indian Citizen; and
- The age of the candidate should not be more than 20 (Twenty) years as on the date of application.

### **Intake and Reservation: 60 Seats (Unreserved Seats + Reserved Seats)**

The Reservation Policy of Maharashtra, as envisaged in the Maharashtra National Law University Act 2014, would be made applicable. Applications are called for below mentioned categories:

## Admission Procedure:

The admission process for **B.A.LL.B. (Honours in Adjudication and Justicing)** will be conducted in two stages.

### Stage 1: Submission of Application

Interested and eligible Candidates are required to apply online by registering at <https://erp.nlnunagpur.ac.in/register2.0.html> along with the following documents:

- Passport Size Photograph;
- CLAT 2026 Score Card;
- Caste Certificate (For Candidates of Maharashtra Only);
- Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (If Applicable)
- Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Certificate (For Candidates of Maharashtra Only).
- Ex-Serviceman ward Bonafide certificate from Sainik Board **OR** copy of the Discharge Book or Family Details Certificate issued by the Services Headquarters **OR** an extract of Part II order of

the unit or Record Office **OR** a Dependency Card or relevant certificate may be needed to establish the applicant's relationship with the Defence personnel (For Candidates of Maharashtra Only).

## **Stage 2: Screening and Shortlisting**

**CLAT 2026 Rank:** From the total number of received applications, Four Hundred and Twenty (420\*) applicants (Unreserved applicants + Reserved applicants) will be shortlisted based on the CLAT 2026 Rank at 1:7 category-wise ratio.

\* Typographical error correction (CLAT 2026 Rank: From the total number of received applications, Four Hundred (400) applicants will be shortlisted based on the CLAT 2026 Rank at 1:7 category-wise ratio.)

**Psychometric Test:** Further, the shortlisted candidates will be invited for Psychometric Test and based on the performance in the Psychometric Test, Two Hundred and Forty (240) candidates will be shortlisted to the next level at 1:4 category-wise ratios for Group Discussion (GD).

**Group Discussion (GD):** The shortlisted candidates from Psychometric Test shall appear for a Group Discussion (GD). One Hundred and Eighty (180) candidates will be shortlisted to the next level at 1:3 category-wise ratios for Personal Interaction (PI).

**Personal Interaction:** The shortlisted candidates from Group Discussion (GD) shall have Personal Interaction with the selection panel, including Hon'ble Judges of the High Court, Academicians, and Psychologist/Counsellor, etc.

**Application Fee: Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) for Reserved Candidates, including PWD Candidates.**

### **Note:**

- As on date, the Psychometric Test and Group Discussion will be conducted online; however, the Personal Interaction will be conducted physically / in person at the University.
- **Changes if any, in the mode of conduct of Psychometric Test, Group Discussion and Personal Interaction will be intimated on the University website and through Email.**
- Further, the Candidates who are part of 2<sup>nd</sup> shortlist Based on Psychometric Test need to go for Group Discussion (GD). 3<sup>rd</sup> shortlist Based on Group Discussion (GD) need to go for Personal Interaction Round and separate list will be published for Personal Interaction Round.
- **Further, the University reserves the right to convert the reserved category seats, if no applications are received against the reserved category quota, as per the rules of State of Maharashtra.**
- A schedule for the Shortlisting of Candidates, Psychometric Test, Group Discussion and Personal Interaction will be notified on June 18, 2026.
