Spot Admission Round 2026

Date: 7 September 2026

The Merit List and Waiting List for the Spot Admission Round-2026 will be uploaded on the University website shortly. Candidates are required to carefully read and comply with the following instructions before making any payment or reporting for admission.

These instructions are being issued because certain candidates have submitted applications for **both the B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) Programme and the B.B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) Programme**, and their names may accordingly appear in the Merit List and/or Waiting List of both programmes.

1. Applications received within the notified period

Only applications submitted during the notified registration period, namely:

5 September 2026 at 10:00 a.m. to 6 September 2026 at 5:00 p.m.,

shall be considered for the Spot Admission Round.

Any response or application submitted **before 5 September 2026 at 10:00 a.m. or after 6 September 2026 at 5:00 p.m.** shall not be considered, irrespective of the candidate's name appearing in any list due to a technical, clerical or inadvertent inclusion.

Such candidates must not make any fee payment or claim admission on the basis of such inclusion. The University reserves the right to remove or cancel any such entry at any stage without further notice.

The inclusion of a name in any list shall not, by itself, confer any right to admission. Admission shall be governed by eligibility, category-wise seat matrix, merit, document verification and payment of fees within the stipulated time.

2. Candidates appearing in both programme lists

A candidate whose name appears in the Merit List and/or Waiting List for both programmes must choose **only one programme** for admission.

A candidate shall not be permitted to take admission simultaneously in both programmes. The fee payment and subsequent admission process shall be treated as the candidate's final choice of programme.

Any attempt to secure or retain seats in both programmes shall be treated as a serious misconduct and may lead to cancellation of admission in one or both programmes, forfeiture of fees as per University rules, and any further action deemed appropriate by the University.

3. Priority in case of selection in both programmes

The following rules shall apply:

A. Merit List in both programmes

If a candidate's name appears in the Merit List of both programmes, the candidate must select **one programme only** and pay the prescribed fee for that programme by:

8 September 2026 up to 4:30 p.m.

The candidate must clearly mention the selected programme in the email forwarding the payment receipt.

The candidate must not make fee payments for both programmes.

In case of any discrepancy or conflict regarding the candidate's programme choice, the University shall rely on:

- The programme mentioned in the payment receipt; and
- The programme declared in the candidate's email to the Admission Section; and
- The University's internal records of seat allotment.

The decision of the University in this regard shall be final, subject to applicable rules.

B. Merit List in one programme and Waiting List in the other

If a candidate's name appears in the Merit List of one programme and the Waiting List of the other programme, the candidate must choose one of the following options:

1. Accept the Merit List offer:

The candidate must pay the prescribed fee for the programme in which the candidate has been placed in the Merit List by **8 September 2026 up to 4:30 p.m.** The candidate will then be considered only for that programme.

2. Decline the Merit List offer and remain in the Waiting List:

The candidate may choose not to accept the Merit List offer and may wait for possible admission against the Waiting List of the other programme. In that case, the candidate must not pay the Merit List fee. However, inclusion in the Waiting List does not guarantee admission.

A candidate who does not pay the fee for the programme in which the candidate is placed in the Merit List by the stipulated deadline shall be deemed to have declined that offer. The seat may thereafter be offered to another eligible candidate, and no claim shall be entertained on this account.

Once a candidate has accepted and paid for a Merit List seat in one programme, the candidate shall not be eligible to claim any seat in the Waiting List of the other programme.

C. Waiting List in both programmes

If a candidate's name appears in the Waiting List of both programmes, the candidate may indicate a preference for only one programme.

Such preference shall not create any right to admission. Admission shall depend upon the availability of seats, the candidate's merit position, applicable category-wise rules, document verification and fulfilment of all eligibility requirements.

If the candidate receives an offer from the Waiting List, the candidate must accept that offer by paying the prescribed fee by:

9 September 2026 up to 4:30 p.m.

The candidate must not make payment for both programmes.

4. How candidates must communicate their choice

Candidates whose names appear in the lists of both programmes must send an email clearly stating their final programme preference.

The email must contain the following details:

- Candidate's full name.
- CLAT-2026 application number.
- Category.
- Registered email address and mobile number.
- Programme selected for admission.
- Whether the candidate's name appears in the Merit List or Waiting List.
- A declaration that the candidate is seeking admission to only one programme and understands that any contrary claim may lead to cancellation of admission and forfeiture of fees as per University rules.

The email should be sent to:

admission@nlunagpur.ac.in

The subject line should be:

“Programme Choice for Spot Admission 2026 – [Candidate’s Name] – [CLAT Application Number]”

Candidates accepting a Merit List offer must send the programme-choice email along with the payment receipt. Candidates in the Waiting List should send their programme preference immediately and, if offered a seat, must again ensure that the payment receipt relates to only the selected programme.

The University shall rely on the information provided by the candidate in this email for all further communications. Any error, omission or change of contact details attributable to the candidate shall be the candidate’s sole responsibility.

5. Fee payment

The prescribed admission fee is:

₹3,85,000/-

Candidates selected for admission must make payment through the SBI Collect payment gateway:

After making payment, the candidate must send the payment receipt to:

with a copy marked to:

admission@nlunagpur.ac.in

The programme selected in the payment communication must be the same programme for which the candidate has been offered admission.

Payment of fees shall be treated as the candidate’s unequivocal acceptance of:

- The programme allotted;
- The category under which admission is offered;
- The seat matrix and reservation rules applicable;
- The fee structure and refund policy (if any) as notified by the University; and
- All terms and conditions contained in the Spot Admission Notification and these instructions.

6. Payment for both programmes

A candidate must not pay the prescribed fee for both programmes.

If a candidate makes payment for both programmes, the University shall recognise only one admission, based on the candidate's declared programme choice and the applicable admission rules. Payment of the fee for both programmes shall not confer any right to admission in both programmes or to automatic adjustment of the amount towards another programme.

In such cases:

- The University may, at its discretion, treat one of the payments as valid and the other as void;
- The candidate shall not be entitled to claim any additional seat, preference or priority on account of having made multiple payments;
- Any issue concerning refund or adjustment, if applicable, shall be dealt with strictly in accordance with the University rules and the decision of the University shall be final.

The University reserves the right to initiate appropriate action, including but not limited to cancellation of admission and forfeiture of fees, against any candidate found to have deliberately attempted to block multiple seats.

7. Non-payment and filling of vacancies

Failure to pay the fee within the applicable deadline shall be treated as non-acceptance of the offer of admission.

The University will proceed to fill the resulting vacancies from the Waiting List and/or through further rounds of admission, as permissible under the applicable rules. Candidates are therefore advised to complete the required payment and communication within the prescribed deadline.

The University intends to complete the process of filling the available vacancies by **10 September 2026**, subject to seat availability, eligibility, category-wise requirements, payment of fees and successful document verification.

No candidate shall have any claim over a seat once the deadline has passed and the seat has been offered to another eligible candidate or converted as per the applicable rules.

8. Final fee-payment communication after exhaustion of Merit List

After the initial Merit List is processed and the fee-payment deadline for Merit List candidates has passed, the University shall ascertain the number of vacant seats remaining in each programme and category.

Based on the updated vacancy position, the University will issue a further communication to candidates from the Waiting List, in order of their merit, inviting them to make the final payment of fees for admission against such vacant seats.

This communication shall be sent:

- To the registered email address and/or mobile number provided by the candidate; and/or
- Through a notice on the University website, as deemed appropriate.

Only those candidates who receive such specific communication shall be eligible to make the final fee payment against the remaining vacancies. Mere presence in the Merit List or Waiting List shall not, by itself, entitle a candidate to this final round of fee payment unless expressly communicated by the University.

Candidates who receive this communication must complete the fee payment within the time stipulated in that communication. Failure to do so shall be treated as non-acceptance of the offer, and the seat may be offered to another eligible candidate or dealt with as per University rules.

The decision of the University regarding the number of such seats, the candidates to be invited, the mode of communication and the time limit for payment shall be final, subject to applicable rules.

9. Document verification

All admissions shall remain provisional until completion of document verification.

Candidates who have paid the fee must report for document verification on:

10 September 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Candidates must bring all prescribed original documents and certificates, along with the required copies. If any candidate is found ineligible, or if any information or document submitted is incorrect, incomplete or misleading, the provisional admission shall be liable to cancellation.

The University's decision regarding:

- Authenticity of documents;
- Eligibility under the applicable rules;
- Category validity; and
- Suitability for admission

shall be final, subject to applicable statutory and regulatory provisions.

Any admission obtained by suppression of material facts, furnishing false information or using forged documents shall stand cancelled ab initio, and the candidate may be liable for further action as per University rules and applicable law.

10. Merit, tie-breaking and category-wise seat matrix

The Merit List and Waiting List have been prepared in accordance with the applicable admission rules, CLAT-2026 merit, category-wise seat matrix and University regulations.

In case of tied scores, the University shall apply the tie-breaking criteria as per the CLAT-2026 rules and/or the University's admission policy, as applicable.

The number of seats in each category is based on the notified seat matrix and any subsequent conversions carried out in accordance with the Government of Maharashtra's reservation norms and University rules.

Candidates shall not be entitled to challenge the internal merit ordering, category allocation or seat matrix through individual representations once the lists are published, except as permitted under the applicable statutory or regulatory framework.

11. Conversion of unfilled category seats

In the event that no eligible applications are received against any reserved or designated category notified in the Spot Admission Notification, the University shall, in accordance with the applicable rules, regulations and Government Orders issued by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time, convert such unfilled seats on the day of the spot admission itself.

Such conversion and subsequent filling of seats shall be carried out strictly as per the prevailing Maharashtra State reservation and admission norms.

Accordingly, candidates are advised that vacant category seats, if any, may be merged/converted into other eligible categories and filled immediately during the spot admission process, without further separate notice.

Candidates who do not qualify under the converted category shall not have any claim over such seats.

12. Withdrawal and forfeiture

A candidate who has paid the fee and subsequently wishes to withdraw from the programme must follow the University's withdrawal and refund policy, if any, as applicable to the Spot Admission Round.

Unless otherwise expressly provided in a separate notification:

- Withdrawal after the stipulated fee-payment deadline may result in forfeiture of the entire fee or a part thereof, as per University rules;
- No candidate shall be entitled to claim refund, adjustment or transfer of the fee to another programme, academic year or candidate except as expressly permitted by the University.

13. Final caution to candidates

Candidates must carefully check:

- The programme against which their name appears.
- Whether they are included in the Merit List or Waiting List.
- The applicable fee-payment deadline.
- The programme mentioned in their payment receipt and email.
- The requirement to select only one programme.

No candidate shall be permitted to claim admission in both programmes merely because the candidate's name appears in both the Merit List and/or Waiting List.

The University's decision regarding eligibility, programme allotment, preparation of the Merit List and Waiting List, seat allocation, acceptance of fee and admission shall be final, subject to the applicable rules and regulations.

These instructions form part of the Spot Admission Notification dated 3 September 2026 and must be read together with it. In case of any inconsistency, the provisions of the original Notification and applicable statutory/regulatory rules shall prevail to the extent of such inconsistency.
