QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF LAW / SOCIOLOGY

1. (a) A Master's degree with 55% marks or an equivalent grade in a concerned / relevant / allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university;
(b) The candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and the amendments therein from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET: Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Byelaws / Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET / SET / SLET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities / Colleges / Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions: -
 - a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode only;
 - b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
 - c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
 - d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
 - e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

OR

- 2 The Ph.D. Degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:
 - a Quacquarelli Symonds (QS);
 - b The Times Higher Education (THE); or
 - c The Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note:

1. The Academic score as specified in **Schedule II (Table 3)** of Maharashtra National Law University, Nagpur Service Regulations, 2022, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

2. Candidates with degrees from National Law Universities or reputed Foreign Institution, or who have teaching experience of National Law Universities would be preferred.

3. The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. **Applicants must apply in prescribed format available @ <https://www.nlunagpur.ac.in>**
Applications received in any other format other than the prescribed form will be rejected. Filled in Application form (Hard Copy) with attested copies of all relevant documents should be sent to the **Deputy Registrar (Establishment), Maharashtra National Law University, Nagpur, Waranga, PO: Dongargaon (Butibori), Nagpur – 441108 [Maharashtra]**. Please download the form and fill it carefully and correctly. An application with incomplete documentation or incorrect information is liable to be summarily rejected.
2. **Only the** Maharashtra State domicile candidates can apply for the posts under the reserve category.
3. Applications received after the last date shall not be considered.
4. The envelope should be **super-scribed** as “Application for the post of <--name of the po-->”.
5. E-mail addresses of the candidates (if any) must be mentioned in the proper place of the Application Form.
6. The Applicants are required to send an advance scanned copy of Filled-in Application to recruitment@nlunagpur.ac.in
7. The appointment shall be contractual, initially for a period of Eleven (11) months extendable up to Two (2) years, subject to satisfactory performance of the candidate and the requirement of the University.
8. Similarly, the contract can be terminated by giving a notice period of 1 month by either Employee & Employer.
9. **Applicants who have applied under the Recruitment Notification RN-25 / September 29, 2025 for contractual positions for the post of Assistant Professor of Sociology can pay the additional GST as per the category and communicate the same via e-mail @ recruitment@nlunagpur.ac.in stating that ‘he / she have applied against the same post under RN-25 / September 29, 2025’.**
10. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for interview. The University reserves the right to place reasonable limit on the total number of candidates to be called for interview. Fulfilment of essential qualifications *per se* does not entitle a candidate to be called for interview. Those who are possessing higher qualifications shall be given preference in short-listing the candidates.

11. The University reserves the right to relax any requirements of experience and age for exceptional candidates, especially for those holding a similar position in a reputed educational/ research Institution and having a good track record.
12. The University reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post at any time without assigning any reason. The right is also reserved with the University either to fill or not to fill any position and its decision in this regard shall be final.
13. The University reserves the right to modify / cancel / withdraw any communication made to the candidates(s), even after appointment, if this has been the result of some inadvertent mistake either in the advertisement or the recruitment process which may have been detected at a different stage.
14. The University reserves the right to disqualify any candidate who may have been shortlisted based on wrong information provided by the candidate. Persons who may be selected / appointed based on wrong information supplied by the candidate may be terminated at any stage.
15. The University reserves the right to disqualify any candidate who attempts to lobby or canvass to influence the selection process.
16. Candidates who are currently employed must submit a '**No objection certificate**' from their current employer along with their application, without which their application will not be considered further.
17. The applicants from reserved categories must submit an attested copy of the relevant certificates signed by the appropriate authority along with their application form.
18. The University will not be responsible for either any non-receipt of application sent by a candidate or any delay in receiving the application sent by a candidate, on any account.
19. Applicants serving in Government / Semi-Government organizations / Public Sector Undertakings / Autonomous Bodies must send their applications **Through Proper Channel**. The applications received without the recommendations of the employer (s) will not be considered. However, an advance soft copy of application may be sent followed by the original application through proper channel.
20. Candidates shall have to produce original documents at the time of appearing in Interview.
21. **Incomplete applications** or without relevant supporting enclosures (self-attested copies of degree / certificates / marks sheets / experience certificate, etc.) will be **rejected at the threshold**.

22. Application fee shall be paid through the Bank link <https://www.onlinesbi.sbi/sbicollect/icollecthome.htm> under the category of Educational Institutions (Application Fee Recruitment). The online receipt of fees paid through SBI Collect shall be enclosed with the application form. For safety, it is advisable to send applications by either Registered Post or a reliable Courier Service.
23. The decision of the University authorities during the different stages of the selection process will be final and binding.
24. Selected candidates will be governed by the Maharashtra National Law University, Nagpur Service and Financial Regulations.
25. Canvassing in any form on behalf of any candidate will disqualify such a candidate.
26. The University reserves the right to fill all the positions advertised or fill only some of the positions or not to fill any of the positions.
27. The University will make all correspondence only through email.
28. In case of any dispute / suit or legal proceeding against the University, the jurisdiction shall be restricted to the Courts in Nagpur, which is the Headquarters of the University.
