He received his Ph.D. under the guidance of Dr N S Gopalakrishnan (Director, IUCIPRS, CUSAT) and Professor Dr K B Pavithran (Director, School of Management Studies, CUSAT) in Intellectual Property Rights and Management from Cochin University of Science and Technology in 2017. His PhD was in the issues in legal framework and management of geographical indications in India. He has Post Graduate degree in Commerce (specialisation -Marketing Management) from Calicut University and recently he selected as the Reviewer Journal of World Intellectual Property Rights.
